Dear Parents/Guardians,

Extended Learning Activities (ELA) and Selection of School Sports Teams

This year our ELA programme will operate like last year. Adhering to its excellent traditions - stretching potentials, enhancing self-esteem and team work spirit, developing skills, building character, forming moral values through a wide selection of indoor and outdoor activities. Our ELA will be divided into the following 5 categories.

- I "ACADEMIC"
- II "SPORTS"
- III "MUSIC & ARTS"
- IV "SERVICE"
- V "CULTURAL & INTERESTS"

However, there are separate requirements for the junior forms (i.e. S1 - S3) and the senior forms (i.e. S4 – S5).

For S1 - S3

- Students join at least one activity in the year-long programme or a maximum of three activities in one round, as mentioned.
- They must choose the activities from different categories, where Sports and Music & Arts must be included in S1 to S3

For S4 – S5

- Students join at least one activity or a maximum of two activities, each at a round.
- Students select from at least two different categories of activities in S4 - S5, in which case Music & Arts must be included in this three-year period.
- In S6, students can only participate in one activity in the first round on account of preparation for public exams.

Please read the attached information regarding fees and other details. It is highly recommended that you discuss with your child about the choices they make. Please fill in the attached choice form and bring it to the Enrolment Market.

On 7th and 9th September, 2010, ELA Enrolment Markets will take place in Hall during assembly where students are required to select their options.

A list detailing the final selections for each activity will be posted onto our school webpage under "ELAs" before the start of our 1st round ELA Programme.

We look forward to a fruitful ELA programme under this new scheme.
