Dear Parents of S1 Students,

Thanks to parents' solid support, the College has the tradition that learning trips will be organized for students to address the needs of the curriculum. Each year level will have its own agenda of learning. Accordingly, for S1 students, there will be two trips this year: The first one to Cheung Chau for a local study trip. It will take place during the S4 mid-year exam time, between 25th and 29th January, 2010. The other is the Humanities Macau Trip which will take place during the Easter holidays.

We are in the process of finalizing all details, such as fees and itineraries, but under estimation, the cost per S1 student would be within HK\$1,000.00 for the Cheung Chau trip and approximately HK\$1,500.00 for the Macau Trip. Financial assistance will be available to families that are eligible for support. As well, closer to the times, a letter of consent from parents will be necessary.

As in the past, these learning trips are mandatory. Students will not be granted leave unless they come with very strong reasons for not joining. Those who do not go will have to attend school as usual, to work on assignments under the supervision of the teachers.

We are sure this will be a very meaningful learning experience for your child.
