Dress-Down Day for Haiti Earthquake Victims

In order to raise money for World Vision Hong Kong in coping with relief in connection with the dreadful earthquake that has hit Haiti, the poorest country in the Western World, we want to hold a DRESS-DOWN DAY on Thursday, 21st January, 2010.

We would like each student to wear simple clothing, with at least one black item, as a sign of mourning and we hope each student will contribute a minimum of \$20. If parents would also like to donate, please send the donation with your children. When we did this for the Sichuan earthquake victims last year, we raised \$40,000.

We will also hold a minute's silence in the playground at 1:45 p.m. after lunch.

Obviously, the money we raise will be but a drop in the ocean of what is needed to bring relief to those affected, but we wish to demonstrate that we are caring, sensitive global citizens and that all our hearts go out to those suffering in Haiti.
